### **Saint Xavier University H1N1 Flu Clinic**

What: Free vaccinations available on first-come, first-served basis. No appointment is necessary. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention list the following as high priority groups: Health care and emergency medical service personnel; children and young adults ages six months through 24 years; 25-64 year olds who have medical conditions which put them at high risk for complications from influenza; household contact and caregivers of children younger than six months of age; and pregnant women.
