



H1N1 Vaccines at MHR? I'm trying!

Last night I spoke with Dr. Scott Hanlon from shotfairy.com. He explained several things.

1. When he received vaccines from the City of Chicago, the vaccines must be given in the City of Chicago.
2. When he receives vaccines from the Cook County Board of Health, the vaccines must be given in Cook County. Although he has petitioned the Cook County Board of Health for vaccines, he has not received any, nor word of when he might.
3. After vaccinating St. Rita's students this week (with 1,000 vaccines from the City of Chicago), he had only 300 vaccines remaining. He is scheduled at St. John Fisher School—his online registration was filled in a very short time.
4. Dr. Hanlon will call me if he receives vaccine from the Cook County Board of Health and schedule MHR. He'll also call if he is at a nearby site in Chicago, so that our families can register online for that site and receive the vaccine in Chicago.

I have registered MHR with the Cook County Board of Health, so that, as the vaccine trickles down, we'll be scheduled as a vaccination site. I've attached their flyer, in case families want to call them directly.



WHERE TO GET H1N1 VACCINE IN SUBURBAN COOK COUNTY

- Healthcare providers
- Participating schools & licensed daycares during fall and winter
- Local pharmacies (ages 9 and up)
- Cook County clinics (see below)

PRIORITY GROUPS

The groups below should get the H1N1 vaccine as soon as possible:

- Pregnant women
- People living with or caring for infants less than 6 months
- Healthcare personnel and emergency medical services personnel
- 6 months – 24 years
- 25 – 64 years with chronic conditions such as asthma or other lung diseases; diabetes; heart, liver or kidney diseases

As more vaccine becomes available, these groups should also get vaccinated:

- Healthy people 25 – 64
- Adults 65 and older

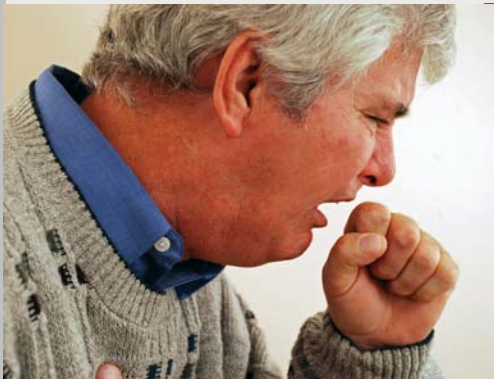
