

Permission Slip for Feature-Length Movie for Grades 5 - 8

Dear Families,

Most Holy Redeemer requires permission from parents to screen certain films for your child during class hours. Throughout the year, we may show a variety of different movies that supplement our curriculum, whose ratings may range from G to PG-13. Teachers *must* have watched any movie they intend to show in the classroom (even if they have seen it previously), checking for their ratings and age-appropriateness. Teachers *must* also visit the Internet Movie Database and read a review of the movie. The teacher will provide alternate plans for the child of any parent declining to give permission for his/her child to watch the movie. We firmly believe that showing certain films will greatly enhance the student's understanding of the subject material, as well as provide an alternate (and entertaining) route for information absorption. Examples of movies that may be viewed include: Hunger Games, The Outsiders, The Giver, Hatchet and Devil's Arithmetic.
