MONDAY - CHRISTIAN

Students will do a special prayer and pledge over the PA to put into practice daily being a good Christian.

WEAR PINK: Students will also pray for all families coping with Breast Cancer as October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. Pink shirts can be worn with regular uniform bottoms. Students will create cards and posters of support and share them with Gilda's Club Chicago, a local cancer support center.

TUESDAY - SERVANT LEADERS

Our service project is a Donation Drive for Homeless Veterans. Each class will be assigned a different suggested donation. Donations will be due on Thursday, 10/27. For bringing in a donation, you may wear pajamas to school on Thursday. To share our solidarity with our veterans, students may wear red, white, and/or blue and regular uniform bottom.

WEDNESDAY - EMPATHETIC

In order to show empathy towards others, students will be asked to perform an act of kindness to someone at school, at home, a neighbor or a family member. Students will receive a paper cross to write out their act of kindness. Upon turning in their cross with their act of kindness, they will receive a Red Bracelet with "MHR - 1% every day!" Students may wear a the shirt/jersey of their favorite team and regular uniform bottom.

THURSDAY - INCLUSIVE

Students (individually or in pairs) create posters for a poster contest showing how MHR includes all people - everyone is special in God's eyes! Posters will be displayed in the halls. Students who bring in a donation may dress in pajamas.
